To be eligible for admission to the Inpatient Neuro Recovery Center, a patient must be medically stable and require 24-hour medical and nursing supervision. The patient must also be able to actively participate in an intensive rehabilitation program consisting of approximately three hours of therapy per day. In addition, the patient should have limitations related to self-care, mobility, cognition, communication and/or swallowing to qualify for entry into the program.
